**NAME: STEVE LE FEVRE**

From hosting his own series of ITV daytime quiz shows to political debates, presenting on Five Live, lifestyle shows and winning a Sony Gold award – Steve le Fevre is versatile and adaptable. He’s currently got the alarm clock set to 4am to present the *Breakfast Show* on BBC Radio Bristol five days a week. It’s three hours of news debate and opinion and sets the agenda in one of the country’s most happening cities. Now based in Bristol full time he also contributes on-screen to *BBC Points West* and *The Politics Show*.

Steve was chosen as the ‘face’ of ITV1 Daytime in 2001 – presenting *Watch To Win* at 9.30 every day – followed by *The Biggest Game in Town* every lunch time five days a week – with an additional 5.00pm edition on Fridays. A live interactive quiz show it needed precision timing – and a game card from the Daily Mirror to play! He also did live promos into *This Morning* and hosted a celebrity edition of *The Biggest Game* with guests Lisa Riley and Sally Lindsay.

Originally from Northern Ireland, Steve started out reading the news and presenting sport and *Grandstand* for the BBC in Ulster. He then moved to BBC Radio Leeds where he won a Sony Gold Local Broadcaster of the Year for his mid morning talk show. Next it was ‘down the road’ to become a well known face with Yorkshire Television as a presenter on a wide range of shows from the Evening News programme *Calendar* to *Tonight*, *Live Lunch*, *Missing* and prime time documentaries and entertainment shows.

Weekends have featured large in Steve's broadcasting career. He wrote and presented *The Media Show* on BBC Radio Five Live every Sunday for two years. "It was a great chance to talk to people in the industry about what was happening behind the scenes – from the Edinburgh Television Festival to Corrie Street." Never a 9-5 man he also presented *The Midlands at Westminster* from Birmingham on BBC2 and the *Saturday Breakfast Show* on Radio Leeds.

Steve presents corporate DVDs and events for many organisations including Asda, Morrisons & HBOS.

When Steve has spare time he likes to spend it with his family, play a bit of tennis, watch Man U and catch up on his sleep!
